

Wireless Service Usage Agreement

THIS CONTRACT SERVICE AGREEMENT (herein “Agreement”), is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 20_____, by and between the Frankfort Independent School District, (herein “FIS”) and the property’s owner/lessee _____ (herein “User”). The parties hereto agree as follows:

1.0 Usage

1.1 Scope of Services

FIS and the Frankfort Plant Board have come to an agreement, which provides internet access in the homes of FIS students who have previously not had access. This service is made available to all FIS students who reside in the district as well as FIS tuition students who reside outside the district and reside in the Frankfort Plant Board's service area. This access is for the use of school work, which includes but is not limited to, communication, studying, accessing Google Drive and Summit Learning. It is not meant to be used to stream TV, movies or games. This service provides opportunities for students to extend their learning beyond the school day by accessing the World Wide Web. This service agreement can be terminated with or without cause at any time by FIS or the Frankfort Plant Board.

1.2 Appropriate Usage

By accepting this service free of charge you are agreeing to use the service appropriately, meaning anyone using the service will NOT use it for illegal or inappropriate purposes. If the service is used inappropriately or for illegal use, termination of services (see section 4.1) will occur and legal action may be taken by authorities.

2.0 Equipment

2.1 Frankfort Plant Board

The equipment, upkeep and maintenance for the services will be provided by the Frankfort Plant Board. It is the responsibility of the User to manage the equipment and not harm or damage the Frankfort Plant Board's property. Damage fees may be applied based on the contract with the User and the Frankfort Plant Board.

2.2 Fees

A charge of \$15.00 will be applied to your monthly Frankfort Plant Board bill, along with a credit of \$15.00, equalling a monthly charge of \$0.00 for internet access.

2.3 Relocation

Service will be terminated and equipment must be returned to the Frankfort Plant Board

or FIS if there are no more FIS students living at the User's address due to relocation or any other issue.

2.4 Transfer of Services and Equipment

If the User moves to an address that is not on the current Agreement, services will be terminated at the Agreement's address and equipment must be returned to the Frankfort Plant Board or FIS. A new Agreement may then be signed between FIS and the User to obtain services at the new address if FIS students reside at the new address.

3.0 Length of Services

3.1 Term

The length of this service will depend on the enrollment of FIS students at the User's address and the contract term between FIS and the Frankfort Plant Board.

4.0 Termination of Services

Immediate termination of services will occur if the following take place:

4.1 Improper Use

Improper use of services includes but is not limited to accessing illegal or inappropriate web material, cyberbullying and inappropriate interactions on the web.

4.2 Graduation

If the student(s) in the User's household graduate and there are no more remaining FIS students in the household.

4.3 No Remaining FIS Students

If there are no remaining FIS students at the User's address.

4.4 Damaged Equipment

If the equipment given by the Frankfort Plant Board is intentionally damaged by the User

or a member living or visiting the User's address.

When services are terminated all equipment must be returned to a FIS location or the Frankfort Plant Board.

5.0 Retention of Documents

5.1 Records/ Report Cards/ Diploma

If the Frankfort Plant Board's equipment is not returned to a FIS location or the Frankfort Plant Board after service termination, then formal records such as, report cards, and student diplomas can be withheld from any FIS student living at the User's address.

6.0 Internet/Electronic User Agreement

6.1 Signed and Attached User Agreement

A signed copy of the FIS User Agreement (found on page 6) must be attached to the Agreement for every student living at the User's address in order for a household to receive these services. This Internet/Electronic User Agreement (page 6) will need to be signed and turned in at the beginning of every school year.

6.2 Refusal of User Agreement

If a parent does not grant permission for their student(s) to have internet access at school, then they will not be eligible for the free internet services provided by the Frankfort Plant Board through the agreement with FIS.
